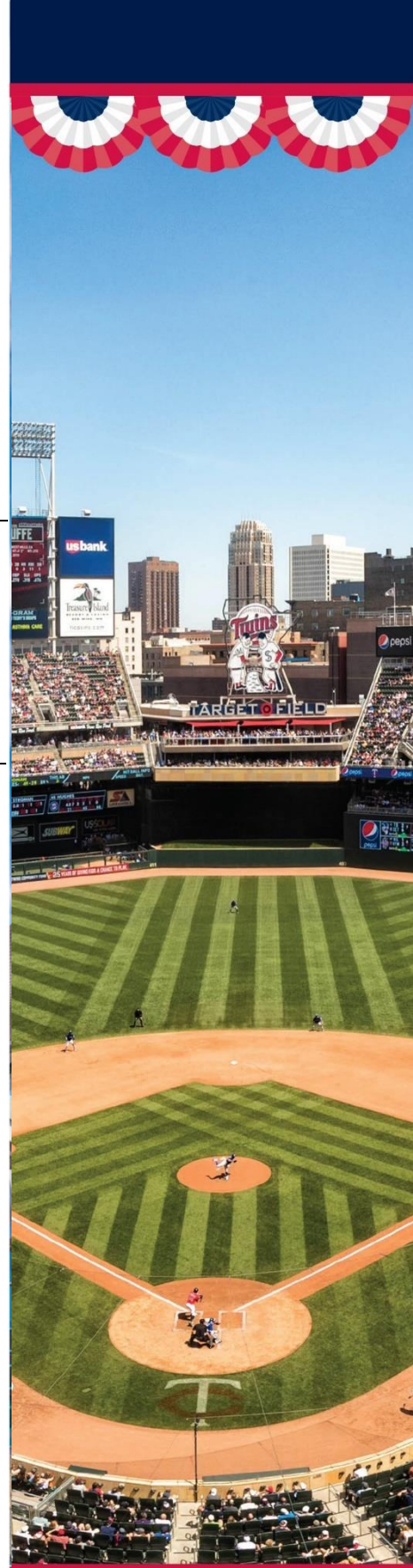

- After entering the stadium, parade participants should proceed immediately to the North Pedestrian Ramp located behind Section 129 in Left Center Field and arrive no later than 12:00 PM.
- At direction of Twins Staff, the group will enter the playing field via the gate in left field and will parade clockwise along the dirt "warning track"
- After conclusion of the parade, participants will be directed back up the (same) North Ramp and will re-enter the Target Field seating "bowl" near Section 129.
